Meeting Minutes

June 25, 2015

The June 25th KRA meeting was called to order by President **Mark Gietzen** at 7:00 pm, at the Golden Corral West Restaurant in Wichita.

After the Prayer and Flag Salute, an abbreviated copy of the minutes of the April meeting, were approved, with the full copy to be posted on the KRA website.

The Treasurer's Report was published on the back of the Meeting Agenda. It included all financial activity from the last Treasurer's Report on April 23, thru June 25th at noon. The Treasurer's Report was approved by a unanimous voice vote.

The featured speaker was the **Honorable Senator Steve Abrams** of Arkansas City, who gave an interesting report on the 2015 Legislative Session, including an in-depth explanation of the budget process, which caused the session to go so long.

Senator Abrams presented printed material on the Kansas Education budget, comparing it to other states

and to past years in Kansas. **Senator Abrams** also presented printed documentation on KEPERS funding and explained what had, and had not, been done in the past to adequately fund the state's retirement responsibilities, and explained, in detail, the current actions by the Governor and the Kansas legislature.

There were so many questions from the floor that Senator Abrams directed some of them to Hon. Representative Steve Brunk and to Hon. Senator Mike Petersen, who were also in attendance.

New Business included a resolution recommending that the Wichita City Council choose a local person as **Wichita Chief of Police**, rather than someone from another city. The pros and cons of this resolution were discussed and voted on. The vote was by voice-vote. In the end, all but one votingmember present favored the resolution.

President **Mark Gietzen** made a detailed announcement about the 2015 NFRA Presidential Preference Endorsing Convention, to be held in Nashville, Tennessee on August 28-thru-30th. The NFRA Convention will replace the local August meeting, so the next meeting will be on Sept. 24th.

The meeting adjourned at about 8:45 pm.
