AN ACT concerning certain municipalities; relating to disclosures.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

Section 1. (a) All Kansas cities and other local governmental units providing water service that artificially fluoridate their community drinking water must notify the consumers of that treated water, that the water is artificially fluoridated and that scientists do not agree whether drinking fluoridated water is beneficial or detrimental to consumers' health.

(b) Nothing in this section applies to naturally occurring fluoride in community water systems that do not artificially fluoridate their drinking water supply.

(c) Nothing in this section applies to water treated for industrial purposes that is not intended to be consumed by humans.

(d) Kansas cities and other local governmental units providing water service may comply with this requirement by printing a notice on utility or water bills that are already routinely sent to the consumers of the artificially fluoridated water, or by any means that, in the opinion of community leaders, adequately makes the consumers of the fluoridated water aware of the fact that the water is artificially fluoridated and that scientists do not agree whether drinking fluoridated water is beneficial or detrimental to consumers' health.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
